




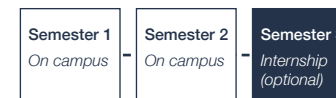

<sup>1</sup>HIP (Hospitality Immersion Program) is optional. HIP is an intensive preparatory course designed for Glion Master's students who have not previously studied a hospitality degree or worked within the industry. It begins four weeks before the designated start of formal Master's studies, leading seamlessly into the first semester. Classes and workshops cover core hospitality areas such as food & beverage (F&B), front office, and rooms division, while also enhancing soft skills including communication, teamwork, and intercultural fluency.
