



All Master's programs at Glion require an interview to assess an applicant's suitability.

These interviews will involve a discussion between you and a member of the Program team for your chosen subject. You will be asked to discuss why you want to study your program and what makes you a strong candidate.



Be prepared

Research the program and the institution: Learn about the program you are applying for, its curriculum, and Glion's mission, vision, and values.

Prepare for common interview questions: Anticipate common questions related to your background, motivation (why Glion? Why this specific program?), and goals. Practice your answers to increase confidence.



Create a positive first impression

Dress appropriately: Wear professional attire that is appropriate for an applicant interview.

Prepare for the virtual interview: Make sure you have a reliable internet connection and a quiet place to participate.

Arrive on time: Join the meeting slightly early to help settle in and calm your nerves.



Be you

Show enthusiasm: Express your interest in the program and Glion and be sure to ask relevant questions about the program.

Be honest: Be transparent about your strengths and weaknesses and what you hope to achieve through the program. Learning is about growing so you are not expected to have all the answers.



Ask your questions

Take full advantage of the opportunity to ask your questions – whether they be about the program curriculum and structure, program delivery mechanisms, facilities, and resources or more about the holistic learning experience you can expect.

Share your passion

Demonstrate knowledge of the luxury industry: Show that you have a deep understanding of the luxury industry, its challenges, trends, and opportunities.

Discuss your experience in guest experience management: Explain any relevant experience you have in guest experience management and how it has prepared you for a career in luxury management.

Show an understanding of the luxury customer: Demonstrate your understanding of the needs, wants, and expectations of the luxury customer.

Articulate your career goals: Clearly explain why you want to pursue a Master's degree in Luxury Management and Guest Experience and how it aligns with your long-term career goals.

Interested in the MSc Hospitality Business Leadership

Discuss your international experience: Explain any international experience you have and how it has prepared you for a career in international hospitality. If you are a career changer share your thought process on what experience you wish to gain to strengthen your operational experience.

Show cross-cultural competencies: Discuss how you have successfully navigated cross-cultural situations in the past and how you plan to continue to do so in the future.

Show leadership skills: Explain how you have demonstrated leadership and problem-solving skills in past experiences.

Articulate your career goals: Clearly explain why you want to pursue a Master's degree in Hospitality Business Leadership and how it aligns with your long-term career goals.

Interested in the MSc Hospitality Entrepreneurship and Innovation

Demonstrate entrepreneurial skills: Provide examples of past experiences that demonstrate your entrepreneurial mindset and skills

Articulate your business idea: Explain your business idea and how you plan to develop and grow it through the master's program. If you do not have a specific idea, share some examples of entrepreneurial ventures that excite you.

Show understanding of the entrepreneurial ecosystem: Demonstrate your understanding of the entrepreneurial ecosystem, including funding, mentorship, and networking opportunities.

Discuss your vision for the future: Explain your vision for the future and how you plan to use the skills and knowledge gained from the program to achieve your goals.

Demonstrate knowledge of the real estate, finance, and hotel development: Show that you have a deep understanding of the industry, its challenges, trends, and opportunities.

Discuss your experience in real estate finance: Explain any relevant experience you have in real estate finance and how it has prepared you for a career in this field.

Show an understanding of the hotel development process: Demonstrate your understanding of the key aspects of the hotel development process, such as site selection, financing, design, and construction.
