

Why you can feel safe on our London campus

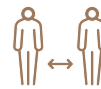
Your safety on campus is our number one priority. We have introduced these key precautionary measures at London campus, in readiness for our students' return. They all align with, or go beyond, the advice of UK health authorities*

Wearing of face masks is compulsory on campus

Our new safety measures at a glance



In all campus public areas

- Numerous hand sanitizers available in all public areas
- Mandatory wearing of face masks in Downshire House
- Flow direction/patterns marked on the floor, to enable social distancing



Main entrance and reception areas

- Equipped with automatic thermal cameras that measure body temperature
- Specific protocol in place (immediate isolation, meeting with health team, etc.) for any instances of excessive body temperature readings
- All students and staff must enter in single file



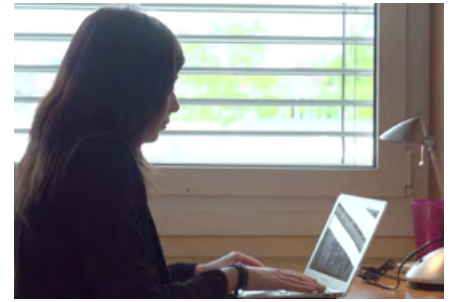
Classrooms

- Seating with two meter plus distance between students
- Students allocated to a specific classroom i.e. no change of classrooms during a given day
- Regular opening of doors and windows
- Cameras installed in classrooms for live broadcasting to enable remote learning for all students
- Video recordings available on Moodle within 24 hours
- Plastic screens used to separate students from the teacher



Library

- Enhanced cleaning and hand sanitizer available to visitors
- Mandatory wearing of face masks
- Social distancing measures in place
- Revised procedures, including returned books being quarantined for 72 hours before being shelved
- Use of online resources is recommended



Self-isolation measures

- Remain in your bedroom and away from others
- Email london.studentaffairs@glion.edu
- The Health Team will contact you regarding your support during self-isolation
- **Follow self-isolation advice from NHS 111**



Accommodation

- Students are in charge of the cleaning of their own room. Campus staff are advised not to enter a room once occupied
- Cleaning supplies provided
- Self-isolation guide available in each room
- Food deliveries in place for students self-isolating
- Covered waste bins



Student Medical Centre

- General practitioners available on the main campus from Monday to Friday, from 9.30 am to 5 pm
- Queen Mary's Hospital opposite the campus
- Security team on call 24/7
- We will maintain regular contact with local medical network and public health authorities
