Terms and Conditions

Application Fee

A non-refundable fee of AED 1050/USD 286 is required with each application for Abu Dhabi Hospitality Academy - Les Roches. Please see section on "Method of Payment".

Damage Deposit

A refundable damage deposit of AED 4,000/USD 1'089 is charged with a student's first invoiceand will be reimbursed three months after the final check-out at the end of the studies.

The deposit covers any costs due to damage to Abu Dhabi Hospitality Academy - Les Roches property as well as any remaining balance, if sufficient, at the time of the final check-out.

Pre-payment (reservation)

New students: Upon receipt of the offer letter, a payment of AED 20,000/USD 5,445 is to be paid within 15 days from the date on the offer letter, in AED. This non-refundable deposit guarantees the reserved place in the program and is automatically deducted from the first semester's invoice. In case an accepted candidate postpones his/her studies, the balance will be carried forward to the next two subsequent intakes.

Tuition fees and fees associated with the studies

The compulsory academic expenses cover the following:

- Tuition fees
- School supplies
- Access to academic facilities on campus
- (e.g. Learning and Resources Center access, and digital learning support) and academic

- Career and internship guidance and professional development opportunities (career fair, industry workshops, personalized counselling, job search, etc.)

- Contribution to specific campus organized events (e.g. leadership series, industry events) and extra-curricular activities and conferences (may incur participation fees depending on type of activity)
- Contribution to examination costs (except resit or retake examinations)
- Access to Microsoft Office automation licenses
- Contribution to Alumni services (lifetime membership to the Les Roches Alumni Association, access to networking and reunion events)

Please note any unused services, clothes, supplies, benefits, etc., included in the mainfees are not refundable.

Learning Resources (compulsory)

Learning Resources are tailored to suit the needs according to each semester level and program and usually comprise a variation of different support material such as digital resources, online accesses to software and databases.

Accommodation

Accommodation is available through our partner hotel group, Rotana, at three hotels conveniently located less than three kilometers from the campus. It is highly recommended for Semester 1 students to become part of the Les Roches family. It is important to note that new students arriving would require a residence permit to rent their own accommodation, which will be available at least one month after your arrival in the UAE.

The hotel options, ranging from 3 to 4 stars, are situated in the same complex and offer a variety of accommodation, from standard rooms to suites and studio apartments. All options include gym and pool facilities, as well as housekeeping. The complex also features multiple restaurants, grocery shops, and cafes.

The accommodation package starts at AED 33,750/USD 9,190 for five months and AED 40,500/USD 11,025 for six months. Reservations will be managed through the Academy.

Meals

A compulsory buffet lunch is provided on campus from Monday to Friday as outlined in the fee schedule. Breakfast (AED 30/USD 8) and dinner (AED 60/USD 16) are available at a discounted price at the Rotana hotels located next to the campus and can be arranged at the student's discretion.

Insurance

Health insurance coverage is compulsory by law in the UAE. Therefore, all students under the Academy's visa are automatically covered with the insurance provided by the school. This covers them for health and accident, while on campus and on internship.

However, domestic students who choose to remain on their parents' visas must obtain theirown health insurance and provide proof to the Academy. Students keeping their private health and accident cover are responsible for verifying that their documents are valid while inthe UAE or abroad.

Abu Dhabi Hospitality Academy - Les Roches cannot be held responsible for the theft of personal belongings, student damage or third party insurance.

Personal expenses

It is estimated that students require on average sum of AED 5,000/USD 1,361 per month to finance their breakfast, dinner, transportation, out-of-pocket expenses such as snacks and drinks, entertainment, personal supplies, laundry, and any other personal expenses.

Internships (if applicable)

Although internships are generally paid by the employer, the remuneration received cannot be expected to finance studies at Abu Dhabi Hospitality Academy - Les Roches.

Residence Visa information

All international students require a Residence Visa to study in the UAE. The Academy will apply for their visa, subject to approval from the UAE Immigration department. UAE residents may choose to either be sponsored by the Academyor remain under their parents' or guardians' sponsorship.

All visa charges are subject to government changes.

VisaProcessing:

The Academy's Admissions Department will handle your visa application once you're accepted into a program.

Processing typically takes around 4 weeks. An electronic entry visa will be issued by email (GCC nationals are not required an entry visa).

Upon Arrival in the UAE:

Students will undergo a medical examination to finalize paperwork.

All international students, including those from GCC countries, will apply for an Emirates ID Card in Abu Dhabi.

Visa Renewals:

Annual renewals require repeating the medical exam, renewing your Emirates ID Card, and submitting your passport and insurance card to the Registrar Department.

Visa Cancellation:

To cancel your visa upon completing your studies, inform the Registrar Department three weeks before your departure.

You'll need to provide your passport copy, Emirates ID Card, and medical insurance cardfor cancellation.

Late cancellation fee & refund policy

Except as described hereinafter, all fees outlined and paid for are non-refundable.

If a new student cancels before the official arrival date on campus, only the prepayment (reservation) will be retained (see above). If a returning student cancels his/her studies after the deadline mentioned below and without a written notification, a late cancellation fee of alate cancellation fee of AED 12,000/USD 3,268 will be charged to the student's account:

New students: 15th of May

(for the Fall intake)
15th of November

(for the Spring intake)

Returning students: 15th of June

(for the Fall intake)

1st of December (for the Spring intake)

If a student is suspended, expelled, or withdraws on his/her own wish once the semester has started, no fees will be reimbursed. In case of mitigating circumstances (e.g. medical, financial hardship, or similar), validated by a member of the school's leadership as part of the early check-out procedure, exceptions may apply.

At the end of the studies (or if the student definitively withdraws), the sponsor can claim for the refund of the positive balance for a maximum of two years after the last official check-out day of their last on campus semester.

Payments

Unless a payment plan contract has been approved, payments must be made in full in AED no later than:

New students: 15th of May

(for the Fall intake)

15th of November (for the Spring intake)

Returning students: 15th of June

(for the Fall intake)

1st of December (for the Spring intake)

Payments can be made by bank transfer, check, credit card or online.

Students will not be permitted to begin their studies until payment for the semester has beenreceived.

Each scholarship has specific criteria. Eligibility for a scholarship is examined on a case-by-case basis for those candidates who have submitted acomplete application. Returning students faced with extreme financial difficulty may apply for Financial Aid with the Registrar at studentservices@lesroches.ae(subject to conditions). Applications must be made atleast four months prior to the start of the intended semester of study.
